KLF POLICY 06

NATIONAL WIDE LIFESAVING DEVELOPMENT

POLICY STATEMENT

The Kenya Lifesaving Federation shall include within the organizing of all meetings, Competitions, conferences, and other events, opportunities for lifesaving representatives from Remote counties to attend at reduced cost. Where possible, this will include a 50% or greater waiver of entry fees and related expenses (e.g., food), identification of accommodation that is substantially discounted from that offered to other attendees, inexpensive or no-cost transportation in-country, and assistance with transportation from/to the country of origin. Such assistance should be included in bidding and organizing documents.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to promote the development and continued viability of lifesaving in the remote counties of the nation. While lifesaving is well established some counties, it is absent or poorly established in most remote counties. The primary barrier is cost. As an organization which is, by nature, primarily composed of lifesaving federations from developed nations, and as an organization which emphasizes the value of developing lifesaving around the country, the KLF should take every reasonable step to encourage participation of lifesaving representatives and organizations from Remote counties.

PROCEDURES

The organizers of all meetings, competitions, conferences, and other events held under the aegis of the KLF shall be required to act in accordance with this policy and will be so informed by KLF Headquarters. The KLF functionaries developing bidding and organizing documents shall ensure compliance with this policy.
